Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

For most of us, when the month of August draws nigh, we know that changes are coming soon—a change in weather, a change in our apparel, a change in our schedules, a change in our activities, often a change in our focus. These are just a few of the changes. Some of those changes are welcomed, some--not so much.

A big change in our family is that our youngest child, Elise, will be leaving her job as a Bible Camp Program Director near Williston, ND, and venturing 4,200 miles across the Atlantic Ocean to serve our parent church, the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, in its Young Adults in Global Mission (YAGM) program. She will be in England doing this mission work in a church in the south London area for 10-11 months. Some of you, I'm sure, are a little familiar with YAGM as Hailey Brenden from our church, New Life, served our denomination in this missionary program a few years back.

While I'm excited for my daughter in this new adventure, I'm also concerned—it's a long way away. I've already been studying maps of London and the surrounding area, and going online trying to figure in what areas she will be relatively safe, and what areas she should avoid—as if she's going to listen to her dad.

With this weighing on my mind, I came across this short devotion as I was preparing to write for this newsletter . . .

Em Griffin writes, in <u>Making Friends</u>, about three kinds of London maps: the street map, the map depicting throughways, and the underground map of the subway. "Each map is accurate and correct," he writes, "but each map does not give the complete picture. To see the whole, the three maps must be printed one on top of each other. However, that is often confusing, so I use only one 'layer' at a time.

"It is the same with the words used to describe the death of Jesus Christ. Each word, like redemption, reconciliation, or justification is accurate and correct, but each word does not give the complete picture. To see the whole, we need to place one 'layer' one top of the other, but that is sometimes confusing--we cannot see the trees for the whole! So, we separate out each splendid concept and discover that the whole is more than the sum of its parts." [John Ross.]

While there are many layers to being a parent, as we watch our kids grow and mature and venture out into a complicated world, perhaps the most important layer is the foundational one—the one that makes all others possible, the one that reminds us that God is love, that God risked it all to redeem us, to reconcile us to God and one another, and to make us, not perfect, but truly whole again. And Christ's mission to make his redeeming, reconciling, justifying love known, is now our mission, as well. That involves some risk—but it's all part of that mysterious, scary, wonderful process of trusting God.
